Biography

Biography is an elaborate description of a particular person's life. It is made up of two words "bio" means life and "graphy" means to write. Biography includes the description of a person's life from birth to death or his current age at the time of writing his or her biography. AUTOBIOGRAPHY

An Autobiography is the self written documents of a person's life. "Auto" meaning "self", "bio" meaning "life", "graphy" meaning "to writ". An Autobiography is reflective in nature. At a certain point of time in a person's life he/she decides to reflect upon his past experience and life. So when he/she writes about his/her past life, experiences, likes, dislikes, view-points, thought processes etc, it is called an autobiography. It is written by the person himself and sometimes the concerned person dictates his/her life events to someone who helps him to write it.

Captain John Smith's autobiography published in 1630 is widely regarded as the first available autobiography readers.

Another eaxample of autobiography is John Banyan's Grace *Abunding of the Chief of Sinners* 1666.

Mahatma Gandhi's *The Story of My Experiment with the Truth* is Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi's autobiography.
